Essential Duties and Responsibilities

The duties of a Hardin County Sheriff's Office Deputy Sheriff - SRO include, but are not limited to: Perform duties of Peace Officer in accordance with State statutes and established departmental policies and procedures; and perform other associated duties as may be assigned by the school district and campus personnel. A detailed job description will be discussed if called for a personal interview.

Qualifications

Minimum qualifications include: Applicants must be at least 21 years of age; Must hold current TCOLE Basic (or higher) Peace Officer Certification obtained through an approved and accredited program; Graduation from a High School or GED equivalent is required; Must be a United States Citizen; Valid Texas Driver's License; Must pass a physical exam, drug screen, psychiatric exam, and thorough background investigation; Have working knowledge of computers; Skill or ability to type and enter information accurately; Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing. Applicant should have experience in school campus security and juvenile law. Ideal candidates will be certified as an SRO and experience serving as an active SRO in last five years.
