Stabilization assistance is now available for qualifying residents **of Hardin County.**

Applicants must be at or below the 200th percentile of the Federal Poverty Level in order to qualify for services. (See chart below).

- An application is to be completed and supporting documentation provided at the time of appointment to be considered.
- * • Case managers will be on site for in-person intakes and to determine eligibility for services.

What to bring:

- Valid picture ID showing residency in Hardin County.
- Utility bill(s) needing assistance with.
- Wages: Paystubs, award letters, income, etc..for all household members over the age of 18.
