ORDER RESCINDING THE ORDER RESTRICTING OUTDOOR BURNING

The Order Restricting Outdoor Burning for unincorporated areas of Hardin County issued by the County Judge on October 6, 2022, and continued by the Hardin County Commissioners Court on October 11, 2022, is hereby rescinded effective as of 1:00PM this date.

While *severe* drought conditions in Hardin County have subsided for now, drought conditions still exist and, therefore, the danger of fires spreading continues to be a hazard, although slightly mitigated by the recent rainfall received. Should you decide to burn anywhere in Hardin County, please exercise extreme caution! Keep any fires small and contained, and please refrain from burning during high winds or near structures or dead vegetation. Remember - It is a violation of Texas law to leave any fire unattended.
