

## Advertisement and Invitation for Bids

Sealed proposals addressed to the **Hardin County, Texas** will be received at the Hardin County Purchasing Department at 300 West Monroe Street, Kountze, Texas 77625; for furnishing all necessary materials, equipment, superintendence, and labor for the proposed **HMGP-DR-4332 Hardin County/Lumberton Detention Pond**, until **2:00 PM on Tuesday, January 13, 2026**. Bids will, immediately thereafter, be publicly opened and read aloud at the Commissioner's Courtroom, Hardin County Courthouse, located at 300 West Monroe Street, Kountze, Texas 77625. Any bids received after this time will be returned unopened.

Bids are invited for items and quantity of work as follows.

1. Clearing and brush removal of approximately 65 acres.
2. Excavation and disposal of approximately 935,000 cubic yards of material.
3. Approximately 8,360 linear feet of all-weather access road.
4. Approximately 3,497 linear feet of low flow channel.
5. Approximately 850 cubic yards of concrete riprap.
6. Approximately 8,500 linear feet of drainage swale with 1,733 linear feet of down spouts.
7. Construction of inlet structure including upstream/downstream headwalls, 5'x4' box culverts and concrete aprons.
8. Construction of outlet structure connecting to existing detention pond.
9. Material testing and storm water pollution prevention.

All interested parties are requested to attend. All questions shall be received through CIVCAST and addressed by Addendum. Questions will be received until Tuesday, January 6, 2026 at 5:00 PM, CST. Questions submitted after this time & date may not be answered.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to Hardin County or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (at par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The project to be constructed pursuant to this contract will be financed with assistance of the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) administered by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) and is subject to all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, or national origin.

Hardin County reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by the County for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended or otherwise excluded from or ineligible for participation on federal assistance programs may not undertake any activity in part or in full under this project.
