case management, resource referrals, court accompaniment,

transportation, safety planning, crisis intervention, answering crisis hotlines,

creating and hosting outreach events, including presentations to

community partners and educate the public about victim rights and services;

facilitates access to emergency services and connecting victims with community resources, advocate for victims within the criminal justice system, maintain confidential records and obtain and maintain education

requirements/certifications.

QUALIFICATIONS: High School Diploma or equivalent and 1+ years' experience in Criminal

Justice, Social work or other related social services fields experience.
Bilingual preferred, but not mandatory. This position is full time (40- hour

week). Must be able to work on-call one week per month including

weekends, holidays and after hours. Must have reliable transportation, valid Texas Driver's License, the state minimum required automobile insurance. All potential employees are subject to a drug screen and depending on position, physical, driving record check and criminal history review.
