

# NOTICE OF MEETING TO VOTE ON TAX RATE

A tax rate of \$0.502473 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of HARDIN COUNTY.

PROPOSED TAX RATE	\$0.502473 per \$100
NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE	\$0.502473 per \$100
VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE	\$0.525172 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for HARDIN COUNTY from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that HARDIN COUNTY may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that HARDIN COUNTY is not proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC MEETING TO VOTE ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON August 27, 2024 AT 09:00 AM AT Hardin County Commissioners Courtroom, 300 Monroe, Kountze, Texas 77625.

The proposed tax rate is also not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, HARDIN COUNTY is not required to hold an election to seek voter approval of the rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Hardin County Commissioner's Court of HARDIN COUNTY at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

**YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:**

$$\text{Property tax amount} = (\text{tax rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.

The following table compares the taxes imposed on the average residence homestead by HARDIN COUNTY last year to the taxes proposed to be imposed on the average residence homestead by HARDIN COUNTY this year.

### **No-New-Revenue Maintenance and Operations Rate Adjustments**

#### **State Criminal Justice Mandate**

The HARDIN COUNTY County Auditor certifies that HARDIN COUNTY County has spent \$161,875 in the previous 12 months for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. HARDIN COUNTY County Sheriff has provided HARDIN COUNTY information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for reimbursement of such costs. This increased the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate by \$0.001600/\$100.
